Two Years Classroom Course for Class 10th to 11th moving Students

Who Should Join?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Class 10th to 11th moving student. (Targeting IIT-JEE 2014 or AIEEE 2014 or Pre-Medical 2014) Separate classes will be conducted for IIT-JEE, AIEEE & Pre-Medical 		
Course Concept	<p>This course is the best course for IIT-JEE, AIEEE & Pre-Medical preparation because of the longest time availability as compared to other courses. The syllabus moves at a comfortable speed and the student can learn and practice the subjects with enjoyment without any stress and time pressure along with school.</p> <p>This course carefully sets the students on a charted path, which begins immediately after the class 10th examination. The main focus of this course is to develop solid foundation of concepts & fundamentals, and also to sharpen analytical thinking, reasoning and problem solving skills of students, which is essential to succeed in competitive examination. In addition to IIT-JEE, AIEEE or Pre-Medical preparation, this course also takes care of academic requirements of School/Board Examination.</p>		
Course Structure	<p>The entire course is divided into two academic sessions.</p> <p>First Year (During class 11th): During the first academic session, the IIT-JEE, AIEEE or Pre-Medical syllabus, which is common to school syllabus of Class- 11th, will be taught to the students. This syllabus is scheduled to be finished by mid of January.</p> <p>Second Year (During class 12th): Based on performance of the students in internal test series, they are promoted to second year of the course (Fresher Course). During month of March, the students will be given a break of around 30-40 days from the institute. During this period, the students take their annual examinations of Class 11th in their respective schools followed by 'a brief vacation' at home.</p> <p>We finish the course of class 12th and also the complete revision of class 11th syllabus (from competitive examination point of view) by end of December in the following year. Then, students will be relieved from the institute to focus on their Class 12th Board Examinations till the third week of March. We keep conducting Problem Solving Counters and revision classes for students during this period till final examination. After board examination, students resume and revise their preparation for IIT-JEE, AIEEE or Pre-Medical through Major Tests.</p> <p>School Preparation:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Syllabus of board (which is not common in IIT-JEE, AIEEE or Pre-Medical and board) will also be taught to students. Classes for English are also conducted from school examination point of view. Physics & Chemistry Practical will also be covered.

- g. **CP-Scholar Award & Cash Scholarship Rs. 60,000/-** to top rankers in main IIT-JEE / AIEEE / AIPMT for continuing studies in college. For details, refer CP-Scholar Award section in information booklet.

3. **Rules& Regulation for USSP:**

- a. Student eligible for Unique Study Support Program (CP-USSP) is required to produce the supporting documents in original at our admission office at the time of the admission/reporting.
- b. Hostel will be allotted to student on first come first serve basis subjected to availability of seats. As there are limited seats in Priority Hostel hence students are suggested to take admission as early as possible.
- c. Hostel accommodation will be provided under Unique Study Support Program. Student has to pay for food, electricity consumption etc.
- d. Before 7th day of each month student performance in internal tests will be reviewed. For this student has to fill performance review form available at student welfare desk. Based on performance, hostel fee rebate will be extended for subsequent month as per the table given above.
- e. If student performance falls below what mentioned in above table in a particular month then he would not get any rebate in hostel fee for that month. However in subsequent month he/she may get rebate again if he/she performs as per the above table.
- f. If student remain absent in any internal exam under medical reasons then he/she has to take approval from Student Welfare Department in written.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Is there any provision of merit Rebate / fee concession for meritorious students?

Q4. How the topics of 11th will be dealt for 12th students (in Fresher/Entuse Course)?

Ans: For 12th Course students, we teach the entire syllabus of class 11th also. During the session; classes to cover the syllabus of class 11th along with topics of class 12th will be arranged in ration 1:2. However the class for 11th topic will be optional which student may take as per requirement, but the portion dealt in this class will be covered in the tests.

Q5. How the balance will be maintained between school & coaching for 11th & 12th appearing students?

Ans: Along with preparing students for competitive examinations, we do take care of board/school 11th & 12th syllabus & practical. Timing for classes is also kept suitable so that student does not face any conflict between schooling & coaching.

Q6. How will you manage compulsory subjects (English / Hindi) of 11th & 12th class students?

Ans: Career Point provides English classes in addition to PCM/B Classes for 11th & 12th Course Students from school/board examination point of view.

Q7. How many times a student will have to come to CP campus for classes every day?

Ans: Classes at CP are planned in such a manner that a student will have to come only once at CP campus every day.

Q8. How frequently the time table of classes is changed?

Ans: Classes & periodic tests are well planned in advance, and the schedule / time table remain unaltered. Our system is the backbone of our coaching.

Q9. Do you also keep classes late night or at odd time?

Ans: Never! At Career Point we understand that students must get sufficient time for self-study, therefore, we never keep classes late night or odd time. Ans: At Career point, we not only aim at selection of students in IIT-JEE / AIEEE /Pre-Medical but also prepare students for top ranks. For this, we create XL/Rankers batch. Students with excellent performance in our internal test are grouped in to XL/Rankers batch. With need based personal attention, we explore the potential of each such student to the full extent and shape him/her to hit the top rank in IIT-JEE / AIEEE / Pre-Medical.

Q11. What is Problem Solving Counter?

Ans: To assist students even outside the class and to remove their personal doubts which some students do not ask in the routine classes due to hesitation or otherwise, we have developed a unique concept of "Problem Solving Counter".

Q12. What is Knowledge Lab?

Ans: Knowledge Lab is a Technology based Highly Effective and flexible Learning solution to extent help to student out-side the class. Its objective is 'Learn what you want, when you want'. Knowledge Lab lets a student access live recorded lecture by the best faculty members – by subject, by topic and by session. Using this; a student can take any lecture any time incase he/she have missed the class for some unavoidable reason. It is also useful when a student wishes to revise the syllabus by taking the lecture again. For live demo, visit our office.

Q13. I did my 10th /12th class in Hindi medium. In which medium should I take my IIT-JEE /AIEEE / AIPMT coaching?

Ans: You must prepare for these examinations in Hindi medium as all these examinations are held in Hindi also. If you opt English as a medium of your preparation, then during the first 2-3 months you will face a lot of problems due to change in the medium which will divert your focus. Instead of learning concepts of Physics, Chemistry and Maths/Biology, you will devote most of your time and energy in learning English. And ultimately you may lose selection in these examinations.

Q14. Is a student automatically getting prepared for AIEEE, if he is preparing for IIT-JEE?

Ans: No. This is a misconception that if you prepare for IIT-JEE then you would be automatically prepared for AIEEE. Remember IIT-JEE preparation is completely different from AIEEE preparation.

IIT-JEE demands application of fundamentals with accuracy, whereas AIEEE judges your speed to solve problems. When you aim for accuracy, usually you become slow in your speed. Also, the examination duration, types of questions, marking pattern are different in IIT-JEE & AIEEE. For IIT-JEE and AIEEE, you need different types of Study Material, Test Series & Expert Guidance.

That's why Career Point has separate & dedicated divisions for IIT-JEE and AIEEE. Every student should assess his past academic record and do rational self-evaluation. One student should take right decision based on his/her potential & from the beginning he/she should focus on either on IIT-JEE or AIEEE.

Q15. Does your AIEEE division give support to students of IIT-JEE-JEE Division for AIEEE examination preparation?

Ans: Yes! After IIT-JEE examination, Career Point's AIEEE Division extends full support to all IIT-JEE students for AIEEE preparation.
